Short Description

The Accounting Information Systems and Digitization track is interested in research on the link between accounting and information systems. Completed research and research-in-progress papers will be accepted.

The track particularly aims to stimulate the debate and the research concerning the interaction between digital technologies and accounting information systems in order to investigate the relationship between digitization and innovation in the field of financial and management accounting.

In the technology adoption process, organizations face relevant changes regarding:

- How to design, manage, and evaluate the accounting and management information systems, in order to enhance information potential, improve decision making abilities, develop more effective accounting methodologies and performance measurement systems.
- How digital technologies can affect accounting models and other relevant business components (management control systems, performance measurement systems, internal control systems, risk management systems).
- How accounting information systems require a redevelopment of organized human activities and of accounting professionals skills to facilitate successful changes.

The Accounting Information Systems track will cover a wide range of topics. Topics of interest include, but are not limited to:

- 1. Smart technologies in the accounting environment, Smart auditing.
- 2. AIS and digital transformation.
- 3. Accounting and Internet of Things.
- 4. IS evaluation, IS assessment, IT business value, IS costs and benefits.

- 8. Business process modelling for accounting and auditing issues.

Fast Track Publication on International Journal of Accounting Information Systems (IJAIS); The International Journal of Digital Accounting Research (JDAR); International Journal of Digital Culture and Electronic Tourism (IJDCET)

At the authors' prerogative, submitted papers can be considered for publication in the above mentioned Journals. These papers should constitute original research that is not currently being considered for publication or has not been previously published elsewhere.

All accepted papers will be considered for nomination as a fast-track publication by the track co-chairs. Track co-chairs will make the initial recommendation as to whether the manuscript is appropriate for a fast-track publication. Papers recommended by the co-chairs will be submitted to one of the mentioned Journals, to be fast-tracked through the review process by the co-chief editors. While a manuscript may be nominated for fast-track consideration, the journal editors retain all decision rights as to whether the manuscript is acceptable for publication.
